I am closed completely or close early on these dates (these are paid holidays unless otherwise noted.) Please arrange alternate care on these days. I receive one weeks' paid vacation per calendar year as well as five paid personal days. I will also have up to 5 full-day paid Professional Development days as required per the state. I do try to schedule all PD after hours but that's not always possible as these are typically trainings given by the state and are only done during business hours, but if I can take classes in the afternoon and close for half days as opposed to closing entirely, that's what I do. Vacation days are scheduled at least 30 days in advance. Personal days will be scheduled with as much advance notice as possible, but these are also my personal sick days. The most updated version of our calendar including closings will always be the Google Calendar. Dates for closures change annually based on availability of trainings and holidays (for example, I only close for Presidential elections every four years, not for local/state elections).

Please remember that tuition is due based on the spot in my childcare program. It is not based on attendance.
Tuition is due 52 weeks per year.

*While this is a paid vacation, I will be moving during this time. As discussed, we are still looking for a home in the same area, but I don't feel it would be best to be open while moving. This vacation also covers Independence Day.
**I will be open from 8am-10am to allow parents time to vote if needed. I will need to vote as well, and am using the rest of this day for administrative duties.

I offer PNO once a month, included in regular tuition fees, for each of my families. Each family is entitled to one date night/ day session per month, and I really want you to use it! I will engage your children in playful activities, feed them dinner, and provide an age-appropriate craft for them to do. What could be better than knowing that your child can be with their familiar, responsible caregivers and spend an evening in a familiar environment? All this, while you spend some uninterrupted time doing what you enjoy! Weekdays, you may pick up your child by 8pm instead of regular time for full time families, or bring your child back from 5:30pm-8pm if drop in or part time. Weekends, I am available for either a lunch (11am-1:30pm) or dinner date (5:30pm-8pm). I will only take one child per session, so please let me know in advance which you'd like. If you would like to have a PNO on a date that's not already scheduled, you will need to pay additional fees for that day.
